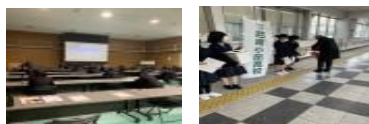

Definition of refugees

- People who have been or may be persecuted when they are in their own country and have fled to another country
- People who sought asylum across national borders to escape armed conflict and human rights violations
- about 82.4 million refugees (at the end of 2020)

What we have done

- Find out the definition of refugee
- We went to learn about refugees in JICA Kansai
- Raise money at JR Amagasaki Station and community center
- Perform *refugee Karuta* at a workshop



Refugee and Asylum Seeker Populations by County of Origin and Destination, 2000-2020

Using data from the UN High Commissioner for Refugees, this map Shows countries of origin and destination for the overall UNHCR Populations of concern, as well as four main subpopulations: Refugees, Asylum Seekers, Internally Displaced Persons, and Venezuelans Displaced Abroad. Select a country of origin or destination for one of these groups, the populations bubbles will then display over countries based on estimated populations size. The default year for the tool is 2000; by using the slider at the top, the year setting can be changed.



We want more Japanese people to know about the refugees issues because refugees need help and acceptance. Therefore, we have created *refugeekaruta* as an easy way for others to learn about the issues. During our workshop children from the local area learned about refugees and enjoyed the *refugeekaruta*.
